Subject: Touchnet Question – How to change the wording on a store page?

QUESTION: We are trying to change the wording on our store page. Where do we go on the backend to change that?

SOLUTION: Follow these instructions. To make this change – You must have the STORE MANAGER role.

Log on to Touchnet Marketplace and select Applications



Then select MARKETPLACE from that dropdown.

On the left side of the page you should have access to Your Merchant (Vet Med Merchant is used in this example.)

Click on <u>Your Merchant</u> then select >> YOUR STORE NAME >> Store settings >> Store Template Setup

You will see the following page – or something similar. Select the **STORE TEMPLATE SETUP option**.





And you should then see this page for your store. Click on the word Announcements.

This will come up on the right side of the page.



On the right side of the "Enter Custom Content" bar there is a drop down arrow.

Click the down arrow – and your web page's custom verbiage should show up underneath it.

Change whatever you need to change – and then click the SAVE button at the bottom right.

That should be all that is necessary to change the verbiage.
