Email notifications in PRODUCT Settings

In addition, each product can be configured with a list of e-mail addresses. When that product is purchased, e-mail notifications will be sent to all the configured e-mail addresses. The configuration for product-level e-mail notifications is located on the **Product Settings** page for each product. (For more details about the configuration setting for product-level notifications, see "Editing Products" on page 310 in the User's Guide.)

Use the following steps to edit a product:

1 From the left navigation menu, navigate to Marketplace Home Click on >[Your merchant name] > Stores > [your store name]


